## How to Use Emergency Contraception

- Emergency contraception (EC) should be taken after unprotected vaginal sex to reduce the risk of pregnancy when birth control was not used or a condom broke.
- May use up to 72 hours after unprotected sex
- Effectiveness decreases the longer you wait
- Effectiveness decreases if over 165 lbs
